[Iran's Fingerprints Are All Over the Temple Mount Turmoil](#)

Palestinian authorities acknowledged Iran's involvement in fomenting the [Temple Mount crisis](#) that followed the July 14 terrorist attack. One of them told *Israel Hayom* that it was "plainly obvious that the government in Tehran, by way of its long tentacles, was behind these efforts.
