German Intel: Iran Still Pursuing WMDs

Iran is still trying to develop a nuclear weapon, according to a report by Bavaria's intelligence agency obtained by Fox News. The 335-page report states that Iran is "making efforts to expand its conventional arsenal of weapons with weapons of mass destruction," Fox News recently reported.

The report is the latest in a series of European intelligence reports that have found Iran to be continuing its development of weapons of mass destruction.
